After an amazing exhibition at Redchurch Gallery London, the World Tour Exhibition of Contemporary Art, organized and founded by Nina Torres, will make its next stop in Miami at Nina Torres Fine Art Gallery. The time to show the exhibition is perfectly chosen during ART

BASEL MIAMI and MIAMI RIVER ART FAIR, where the visitors have easy access to exhibitions and fairs by shuttlebus.

Nina Torres Fine Art has established the first waterfront gallery in the heart of Downtown Miami, in what it promises to be Miami's true cultural destination: the Miami Arts & Entertainment District. The brand new 8,000 square feet gallery space across the street of Margaret Pace Park is located at 1800 North Bayshore Drive, in a high-rise building adorned with fountains and with breathtaking views of Biscayne Bay, Miami Beach and the Port of Miami.

The Switzerland artist becomes excited when she talks about her artworks and invitation at Nina Torres Fine Art. Simone Dehmelt: "My artworks are a reaction of movements in contemporary art: they evolved as an attempt to reverse trends by reintroducing the image as a structural device in painting, to pull art back from the obscurity of abstraction into the real world again. However, there are not 'found objects' that I introduce as a subject for my paintings, but 'found images' - and it is this iconography of familiar signs that appealed to me. My use of such neutral icons offered me a subject that is immediately recognisable but so ordinary that it left me free to work on other levels. My subjects provided me with a structure upon which I could explore the visual and physical qualities of the medium. The results were a careful balance between representation and abstraction."

Simone Dehmelt, born in Switzerland in 1954, received her Diploma in Oeconomics at the University of Zuerich and studied at the Art Academy "Schule für Farbe und Form" in Zuerich/Switzerland. She is member of The Swiss Society of Women Artists in the Visual Arts. Simone Dehmelt is the ambassador of the European Pop Art, whose mixed media paintings are in demand today than ever before. Her paintings embody more than the development of pop culture with artists like Warhol and Rauschenberg at the top. Simone Dehmelt's art plays with visual ideas that have layers of meaning and communicate on various levels. It is both sensual and cerebral, just the way we relate to it. The recent exhibition at Nina Torres Fine Art Miami offers an opportunity in-depth reflection upon Simone Dehmelt 's individual works – to be visited from November 30 to December 22, 2012.
